Camp Hollywood offers a safe day camp for children with multiple disabilities and their siblings.

Campers are encouraged to participate, make friends and learn cooperative skills. Hands-on learning is a real emphasis. Activities include arts & crafts, cooks with books, science & cinema, recreation and music. Outdoor play is not a focus of Camp Hollywood, although some outdoor play may be included. Campers must be 5 (by 09/01/11) to 21 years of age.

LUNCH: All campers must bring a lunch and drink each day in a lunch box that will stay cold. Please do not send lunches that need warming unless medically necessary. Please send any special utensils your camper may need and mark all items clearly with camper's name.

MEDICATION: All medication to be given at camp must be given to the camp nurse or medical professional. All medications must be in the original prescription bottle with accurate dosage information on the label.

TOILETING: Children do not have to be toilet trained to attend FOCUS day camps. Please provide necessary toileting supplies.

COST: The cost for Camp Hollywood is \$145 for the first child and \$110 for each additional child. Camp is from 10 am to 3 pm daily. A \$35 nonrefundable deposit per child is due with this application.

LEVEL OF ASSISTANCE : Camp Hollywood guarantees a 1:4 ratio. Volunteers may lower that ratio.

HOW TO APPLY TO DAY CAMPS

★ Campers may attend one session of Camp Hollywood and one session of Camp TEAM.

★ Applications will be accepted immediately by mail.

No telephone, faxed or email registration will be accepted. Applications are dated as they are received. Space in each camp is limited.

★ Siblings may attend, but each child must have his/her own application. Copy the enclosed application – one per child.

★ Complete application thoroughly. The information you provide may be the only knowledge we have of your child. Incomplete applications may be returned without a camp assignment.


★ A deposit of \$35 per camper per camp must be included and is nonrefundable. This deposit will be applied toward total camp fees. The deposit will only be returned if camper does not get into camp.

★ Camper confirmations will be made by email or mail (see application) by April 15. Final payment is due by May 13 by check or credit card. No refunds after May 13 unless camp is cancelled.

★ Financial assistance may be available for children with special needs. Please complete the scholarship portion of the application.

★ To provide the wonderful setting that FOCUS camps are known for, we must have 24 campers registered for each camp. Apply before April 15 to ensure that your camp location is available with a space for your child!

Camp TEAM offers a rich sensory experience in an outdoor environment. Camp activities are planned to promote growth and development, to encourage improved social skills between children of all abilities and to gently challenge campers. Campers are expected to participate at some level. The camp day is structured and transitions occur every 30 minutes; campers must transition with their group. Day camp includes a ½-day experience for ages 5 (by 09/01/2011) to 6 and a full day experience for ages 7 to 13.

- Ages 4-6
Half-day sessions – 10 am to 1 pm
- Ages 7-13
Full-day sessions – 10 am to 3 pm

LEVEL OF ASSISTANCE: Parents can indicate what level of assistance is appropriate for their child at Camp TEAM. See application.

LUNCH: All campers should bring their own snack. All full-day campers must bring a lunch and drink each day in a lunch box that will stay cold. Please do not send lunches that need warming. Please send any special utensils your camper may need and mark all items clearly with camper's name.

MEDICATION: All medication must be given to the camp nurse or medical professional. Please bring all medications in the original prescription bottle with accurate dosage information on the label.

TOILETING: Children do not have to be toilet trained to attend FOCUS day camps. Please provide necessary toileting supplies.

COST: The cost for Camp TEAM is \$100 for half day participants (ages 4-6) and \$200 for full day (ages 7-13). Additional children are \$90 for half day and \$180 for full day. A non-refundable deposit of \$35 per child is due with this application.

Parents should carefully consider the following criteria to decide if Camp TEAM is the best choice for their camper. Campers must:

- Attend to an activity for at least 5 to 10 minutes,
- Follow simple verbal directions,
- Stay with a group without running or wandering away,
- Engage for several minutes at a time,
- Consistently respond to words of caution,
- Tolerate transitions between activities, and
- If necessary, have a proven behavior plan in place.

All campers will be considered on a case by case basis. Applications will be reviewed and all campers will be considered with safety as the first requirement.
